Patterson-ballagh Corp. et al. v. Moss et al, 201 F.2d 403 (9th Cir. 1953) case opinion from the US Court of Appeals for the Ninth CircuitThe patentee and original plaintiff, Perry M. Moss, assigned the patent, together with the right to recover for past infringement, to Phoebe E. Moss, his wife, prior to the trial. Subsequent to the filing of the action, Byron Jackson Company acquired control of and dissolved the original defendant, Patterson-Ballagh Corporation, assuming any liabilities for infringement of the Moss patent.Truth Hardware Corporation's PlainSite profile, including litigation, intellectual property, public records and more.MR. JUSTICE ROBERTS delivered the opinion of the Court. This was a suit in equity by the respondents for alleged infringement of a patent.
