In linguistics, grammar (from Greek: ??????????) is the set of structural rules governing the composition of clauses, phrases, and words in any given natural language. Hebrew belongs to the Afro-Asiatic family, Semitic group, north-western (or Canaanitic) subgroup, and is spoken by 4.5 million people in Israel. 500,000 are second language speakers. Spoken in ancient times in Palestine, Hebrew was supplanted by the western dialect of Aramaic beginning about the 3rd century BC.
